

COVID-19 Safety, Regulations, Policies

C-Unit Studio

Safety/Regulations

*We will continue to monitor the situation closely, and regulations may change. Below are our current plans for this summer and fall.

- Class capacity has been cut by 50% in each classroom to help ensure social distancing between each dancer. Though dance is an activity that moves around and we cannot absolutely guarantee that dancers will always be over 6 feet apart - our teachers will enforce dancers not touching and regulate that dancers maintain maximum distance possible. All dancer touching, partner work, etc. has been removed from the curriculum for the time being.
- All dancers will be required to sign a waiver with expectations prior to participating in any C-Unit activities.
- We have adapted a drop-off only policy to minimize the amount of people inside the studio. Any dancers under the age of 10 will be met at the door by a teacher, and dismissed outside by a teacher. Dancers will be asked to arrive no more than 5-10 minutes before their scheduled time to ensure we have as little overlap as possible.
- Dancers must wear masks in all common areas, including upon arrival to the studio. Masks will be required inside the classroom through August and September; the guidelines will be evaluated after that.
- Once a dancer enters the studio - they will wait in a line, on the stairs. Each dancer will have their temperature taken by a teacher, be hand sanitized, and check in for their class prior to entering the lobby.
- After entering the lobby, marked signs guide the dancer to put their bag away safely in a cubby and proceed to wash their hands. The bathroom now has a capacity of 2 people.
- After washing hands, the dancer must proceed straight to their designated studio (dancers will no longer be allowed to wait inside the lounge. Inside the studio, there will be designated spot markers for dancers under 10 to ensure distancing is enforced. Upon finishing class, dancers will be hand sanitized prior to leaving the room.
- All ballet barres, door knobs, bathroom surfaces, and frequently touched objects will be disinfected and wiped down between every class. The entire studio will be cleaned and disinfected every morning prior to start of classes, and professionally deep cleaned twice per week.
- Hospital grade filters have been installed in HVAC system.
- Bi Polar Ionizers have been installed in the duct system. The BPI devices create equal amounts of positive and negative ions in the air which attached themselves to virus particles and kill them. BPI equipment works by treating the room air and attacks before being circulated. It has been proven to kill 90% in the air and 80% on services within 10 minutes.
- Brand new hands free water station has been installed

Policies/Pricing

- There is an in-person and virtual option for all classes in 2020-21. Movement, Company, and Hip-Hop Team dancers are required to register for in-person classes.
- While this is still a year long program, tuition is broken up into two payments (September-January, and February-May). A dancer may choose to take the virtual option the first semester, and the in-person option the second semester (depending on availability). Please keep in mind that any dancers participating virtually in the second semester aren't eligible to be in the recital.
- If a dancer displays any symptoms or has been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 – we ask that a dancer stays home and email info@c-unitstudio.com immediately so that we can evaluate, contact trace, and proceed with the proper course of action. You will be provided with a virtual link for all classes missed in-person.
- If a dancer chooses to reserve a spot with an in-person option and then move to a virtual option once classes start - you will receive a credit for the difference to be used towards the second tuition payment.
- If a dancer chooses to start with the virtual option and then “upgrade” to the in-person option (depending on availability) half way through the semester - you will be charged the difference between the two options (without a pro rate for the virtual classes taken).
- If for any reason, we have to fully shut down again due to COVID-19 - we will immediately move to fully virtual classes and the price difference between in-person and virtual classes for the time period of the shutdown will be credited towards the second tuition payment. Each person will be emailed with their credit amount at the END of the shutdown period.
